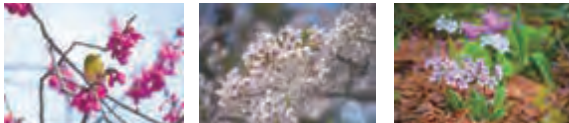

Access by car

- Approximately 8 km from the Kashiwa Interchange
- Approximately 5 km from the Yobatsuka intersection of R16 and R6

Access by bus

- From Abiko Station: get off at the last stop of the bus bound for Akebonoyama Park Entrance, and walk 7 minutes, or get off at the last stop of the bus bound for Akebonoyama Agricultural Park and walk 1 minute.
- From Kashiwa Station, the following buses stop at Akebonoyama Agricultural Park: buses bound for Akebonoyama Agricultural Park, Fuse Benten, and Mitsui Danchi. *Please note that on both weekdays and weekends only the 12:20 p.m. departure arrives during park opening times. Please get off at Akebonoyama Agricultural Park. It is a 1 minute walk.
